This is our third of many Annual Silent Auctions to come. This Auction is being held so that we may raise funds to enhance extracurricular activities here at Northwest High School. We hope that you will donate and bid generously to help us support the students here at Northwest High School. The Silent Auction is hosted by NWHS Boosters with the support of the School Administration, the Athletic Department, The Ambassador Club, Students, Staff and Parents.

**This catalog of items will be updated regularly over the upcoming weeks as donations come in. Please check back with us to see the new items that will be available for Auction.**

\*When you receive your admission ticket, you will be given a personal bid number. Please be sure to list this bid number on the bid sheet with your other information.

\*All of the items at the Auction are sold "as is." We have tried to give complete and accurate descriptions of the items. There are no warranties expressed or implied. Please look at the items and review their descriptions carefully (expiration dates, restrictions, specific limitations etc...) If you have any questions, the Auction staff will try to find the information for you. All sales are final and we can not exchange nor give refunds.

\*NWHS and the NWHS Booster Club are non-profit organizations. Please check with a tax advisor regarding deductions for charitable donations if you have donated items or the deductability as a charitable donation for the amount in excess of the fair market value if you have placed such a bid.

\*The winning bidder will need to take possession the item as soon as payment is received and verified. If the winning bidder has left the auction before the winner is determined, they will be notified Thursday night by phone and payment made via PayPal, we will hold the item until Friday 1:00pm to pick-up unless other arrangements have been made. If payment is not received and verified by Friday 9:00am, the item will go to the next highest bidder on the list.

\*All services and use of property such as vacation properties or weekend getaways are subject to terms of use of that property's management company and the arrangements made with the donator. Any fees incurred through the misuse of such property will be the liability of the user, not the donor.

## How the Auction Works

All auction items will have a bid sheet assigned to them. If you would like to bid on an item, fill out the next available line on the bid sheet with your bid number, name (optional), phone number (Thursday night) and the amount you are bidding. **DO NOT REMOVE THE BID SHEETS**, the bid sheet must stay with the item at ALL times.

Starting bids and minimum bid increases will be listed on the bid sheet for the item. Example: If the starting bid is \$25.00, you cannot bid lower than \$25.00. If the bid sheet has a minimum bid increase of \$10.00, and the last bid was \$50.00, then the next bid must be \$60.00. Please make sure your bid is legible, if we cannot read your bid, the bid will not be accepted.

Bids may not be altered once they are entered. **When placing your bid, that is your agreement to pay.** Do not enter a bid on the bid sheet unless you are willing to buy that item.

A limited number of people will be allowed in the bidding room at one time in order for everyone to have the opportunity to look at items, ease of movement around the room and fire regulations.

Bidding will end on **ALL Silent Auction** items at 7:00p.m. Winners will be announced at approximately 7:30pm during the Live Auction (or on sheets posted outside of the cafeteria). The Auction staff will disburse these winning items once payment is received and verified.

Any discrepancies will be handled by the Auction staff and decisions made by the Auction staff will be final.

### **RAFFLE ITEMS** (held in the Gymnasium along with the Silent Auction Items)

Several items will be available in our raffle. You may purchase raffle tickets (see prices below) and place them in the ticket basket alongside the item that you wish to bid on. Winners will be announced during the live auction or posted on sheets outside of the Cafeteria.

### **CHECK-OUT PROCESS AND PAYMENT**

After the winners are announced, proceed to the check out area. Tell the Auction staff your bid number. You will receive a list of all items that you were the highest bidder on. Please pay for all of your items at once. Payment can be made by cash, check, charge (Visa or MasterCard) All checks need to be made out to NWHS Boosters. You will be given a paid receipt.

Show your paid receipt to the auction staff to pick up your item(s).
